Each year a new crop of issues piques our interest. This year we have added the issues below to our watch list. See the full report here. While this is not a complete list of all measures we are following, they represent a sampling of our high priority targets.

Note: These are *proposed* measures that have not yet been passed unless noted otherwise.

KEY ISSUES AT THE TOP OF OUR LIST: See the <u>Issues on the Radar</u> report for more issues we are following.

- Public Works: Wage Complaints Timeline Extension from 18 to 24 Months (AB 2135)
- Surety Liability for Attorney's Fees (AB 2677)
- Outdoor Heat Illness Certification (AB 2264)
- Workplace Violence Prevention Plan (AB 553) Effective 7/1/24 MCAC template available to members. Passed 2023.
- Indoor Heat Illness Cal/OSHA Regulation
- PAGA Repeal Ballot Measure Slated for Nov 2024 (stay tuned for more details in future reports)

In Memoriam

Stuart "Stu" Robert Beavers

April 15, 1929 - March 2, 2024

Stu Beavers, a dedicated leader in the construction industry, passed away on March 2, 2024, at the age of 94. As a key figure in the Mason Contractors Association of California (MCAC), then known as the California Conference of Mason Contractor Associations or CCMCA, he served as Secretary on its first board of directors in 1963 and later as President in 1966-67. His early



work in masonry was with Modern Masonry, Incorporated. At the time of his passing, Stu was a MCAC Honorary Member, the highest honor bestowed upon the Association's most loyal members. Stu's commitment to the industry was evident throughout his career, including his roles at the Masonry Institute of America (MIA), the Concrete Masonry Association of California and Nevada (CMACN), and his tenure as President of The Masonry Society (TMS). He leaves behind a legacy of leadership, kindness, and expertise. Stu Beavers is survived by his first wife, Virginia, and their son and three daughters, with spouses. His second wife, Martha passed in 2018, and Stu is survived by two of her sons and spouses. He is also survived by numerous grandchildren, great grandchildren and great-great grandchildren. He will be deeply missed by all who knew him.
